2-Competition type

Only trolling fishing at sea with artificial lures, according to regulations of the F.I.P.S-M

3-Areas of competition

Coastline of Var. A fishing area will be defined for each trip and it will not exceed 60 nautical miles from the marina.

4-Authorized kinds of species and minimum weight

Blue fin tuna: 10 kg or 80 cm.

As the regulations could changed, we will take into account which one in effect during the competition.

White tuna: 3 kg200 Coryphene: 3 kg Swordfish: 16 kg Spearfish: 16 kg Others species: 3 kg

All fishes will be marked on board.

Artificial lures as "rapalas" with double or triple fish-hooks are allowed (according to I.G.F.A)

EXCURSIONS ...

Medieval Hyères: 1/2 day

Guided tour of the old city: Return in the past through out steep and vaulted alleys and porches; Towering the old city is the castle, witness of the Medieval past. The gates in the city wall, "Commanderie des templiers" St Paul and St Louis churches, tremendous public gardens of Castel St Clair and St Bernard, villa Noailles, all symbols of a flourishing Renaissance.

Island of Porquerolles: 1/2 day or complete day

You will make the crossing aboard "Vision des Mers" a bottom-glass boat to discover submarine lip. Arrival and presentation of the archipelago of Islands of Gold; history, geology and life. The village is dominated by the Fort St Agathe, from where you will start botanical walk. Free time in the village. Direct way back by boat.

Bormes les Mimosas : 1/2 day

Guided tour of the Medieval village, perched on the hill, looking down over the seaside resort of Lavandou.

Villages of St Tropez 's bay: complete day

Discovering the famous cliff-road of Maures, burdered with many seaside resorts of the coast line: Le Lavandou, Le Rayol Canadel, Cavalière, Cavalaire, La Croix Valmer. Visiting Ramatuelle, the native town of G Philippe. Arrival to St Tropez, where Jet Set and numerous painters will meet.

After lunch, departure to Port Grimaud, "little Venice" where you will make a canal cruise on a flat bottomed boat.

Return through Cogolin, capital of craftsmanship.

Old villages:

Off the beaten track, to discover the heart of the region. Guided tour of the Medieval village of Arcs. Passing through Lorgues, Salernes, Sillans la cascade. The afternoon, free time in Cotignac with its cave dwellings. You will stop to a pilgrimage spot and visit one of the three Cistercians landmarks of Provence: Abbey of Thoronet with its cloister and church.
